BSZ403A (Released 22 Oct 1998)	This unit does not use the term validation, rather it talks about review of the assessment procedures and clearly includes post-assessment review because of the stated resource implications below.	The unit code indicates review happens after assessment:

TAAASS404B (1 Oct 2004)	Application of the unit:  Validation is a process involving assessors working in collaboration to review, compare and evaluate their assessment process and their assessment outcomes in relation to the same unit/s of competency. This includes validating assessment methods/tools, the evidence that was collected using these assessment methods/tools and the interpretation of that evidence to make a judgement of competence.	Clearly the intent was that validation was a process undertaken after assessment.
	Defines the critical aspects of validation:  the critical aspects of validation, including validation of:  assessment processes  methods and tools  the collected evidence leading to assessment decisions assessment decisions	These critical aspects of validation are important because subsequent versions of the unit refer to them but do not define them.

TAEASS403A (18 July 2008) And TAEASS403B (12 Oct 2011)	The unit specifically referenced validation activities including review and analysis of collected evidence and required 2 different validation approaches and activities, but also included the knowledge requirement:  KE2 various reasons for carrying out validation and the different approaches to validation that may be appropriate before, during and after assessment	Introduces the concept that validation can happen before, during and after assessment.  Aligns with AQTF 2007 definition of validation.
TAEASS403 (6 April 2016)	The unit does not reference validation of student evidence and includes the following knowledge requirement:  KE2 the reasons for carrying out validation and different approaches to validation that may be appropriate before, during and after an assessment  The unit includes the following, somewhat mysterious PE:  PE1 actively participating in a minimum of three validation sessions that address the critical aspects of validation	Note, the reference to critical aspects of validation is not defined in this unit but was defined in TAAASS404B.
TAEASS413 (8 Dec 2022)	Application: This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to participate in the validation of assessment tools, practices and judgements, including in:  • pre-assessment validation of assessment tools before they are first used with candidates, and post-assessment validation of the tools after having been used to assess candidates  • post-assessment validation of practices and judgements.  The PE spells out a process of validating tools before they are used (pre-assessment validation), judgements, and practices undertaken during those judgements.	This is where the term 'pre- assessment validation' was introduced to the VET sector.  Annoyingly, even the unit itself couldn't get it right because the KE refer to pre- and post-validation of assessment tools!
	The KE confusingly refers to:	

KE2.5 pre- and post-validation of assessment tools – which I've always interpreted as pre- and post-assessment validation because the AC require having access to:

- assessment tools for pre-validation

- assessment tools for post-validation and samples of completed learner work and results
